

Mrs. Goldie B. Floberg Memorial Leadership Award

The Mrs. Goldie B. Floberg Memorial Leadership Award is a "lifetime achievement" award. It was established to honor an exemplary Center staff, board member, group or volunteer. Qualities or skills considered in the Center's selection of the award winner represent those possessed by Mrs. Floberg, the former Winnebago County Chief Probation Officer. Shortly before she died in 2000 at age one hundred, she was named one of the most important people of the 20th Century in the Rock River Valley.

"For a community to be whole and healthy, it must be based on people's love and concern for each other." Millard Fuller, the author of that quote, must have had the Lions Clubs in mind when he said that! Since 1917. Lions Clubs have helped empower volunteers to serve their own communities, meet humanitarian needs, promote peace and encourage an understanding. international That is the essence of their mission. Perhaps best known for fighting blindness, Lions Clubs are just as committed to many programs and projects which strengthen community members. "We serve" is their response to children and adults



worldwide to meet their health, educational, recreational and social needs. "We serve" is their response to protecting their environment across the planet.

The Roscoe Lions Club was chartered in August 1961 and has a rich history of service in the community. Forty-two years ago, they started the Roscoe Fall Festival, a favorite area tradition. This fundraiser, a weekend of family fun, benefits several local charities, including the Goldie B. Floberg Center. The Floberg Center has been the recipient of their kindness for nearly three decades. Their support has helped provided opportunities for Floberg Center athletes to engage in Special Olympics participation. They have supported the Center's youth in Boy Scout Troop #643 by paying for Camp Indian Trails registration fees. They funded the purchase of AEDs and also contributed to the Center's Playground Project. Their commitment has been vital in enriching the lives of the youth and adults served by the Center. We are thankful for their impact on the lives of the Floberg Center family.
